



PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

“IPSA undertakes to keep your data secure and private. Your data will not be sold or given to any third party and will only be shared with those bodies who have a legal right to request it from us. You may at any time request to see what data is held concerning you and you shall have the right to request rectification of any errors. You shall also have the right to withdraw your consent for us to hold or process your data at any time. ”

Any data collected and stored in the course of business will be used only for “legitimate business reasons”.

The data of Data Subjects will only be shared for the purposes of:

- The investigation or prevention of crime.
- The making of statutory submissions such as tax returns.
- The provision of data requested by regulatory authorities.

Your data will never be sold or given to any third party.
